NOTICE TO ALL AIR OPERATORS

Reference- Disinfection of aircraft cabin

In light of ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal has taken various initiatives to reduce the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) by air transport and to protect the health of air travelers and the aviation personnel. International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) has also issued Council Aviation Recovery Takeoff (CART) Take-off: Guidance for Air Travel through the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis providing guidance for all stakeholders. The guidance contains an 'aircraft module' in which the disinfection of aircraft cabin is highlighted.

Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal has also issued a guidance on "Guidance to Airlines, Airports and Ground Services for Operations during COVID-19 pandemic" that has a provision of aircraft disinfection before each flight. Furthermore, ICAO Annex 9 Standard 2.31 has the provision of disinfection of aircraft when such situation arises.

All air operators operating in Nepal are hereby directed to follow the provisions of "Guidance to Airlines, Airports and Ground Services for Operations during COVID-19 pandemic" that was approved by the Director General, Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal. All COVID-19 related guidance, notices etc. are available in the CAA Nepal website for reference.
