

Sub : About the new standards for Air Traveler

As per the decision of Government of Nepal (Council of Ministers) on 28 Feb 2022, all the passengers travelling to/from Nepal are required to follow the enlisted health protocols with immediate effect ;

- 1) Arriving passengers must submit COVID-19 vaccination certificate before boarding. For those, unable to show off vaccination certificate, must have negative report of COVID-19 test (RT-PCR/True NAAT/Gene Xpert) issued within 72 hours from the time of commencement of travel.
- 2) For departing passengers, concerned airlines must inform and ensure the compliance of COVID-19 health protocols of destination country.
- 3) **Travel mangement order for the Passenger arriving to and departing from Nepal,2078** published in Nepal Gazette part (5), section (71), Ex-extras (56) by Home ministry and **Order for prevention & control of third wave of COVID-19 pandemic with new variant Omicron,2078** published in Nepal Gazette part (5), section (71), Ex-extras (56) by Ministry of Health & Population on 14 Jan 2022, following the decision of Government of Nepal (council of ministers) on 14 Jan 2022, have been revoked. All the acts and proceedings carried out under above two orders shall be deemed to have been carried out under this new order.
